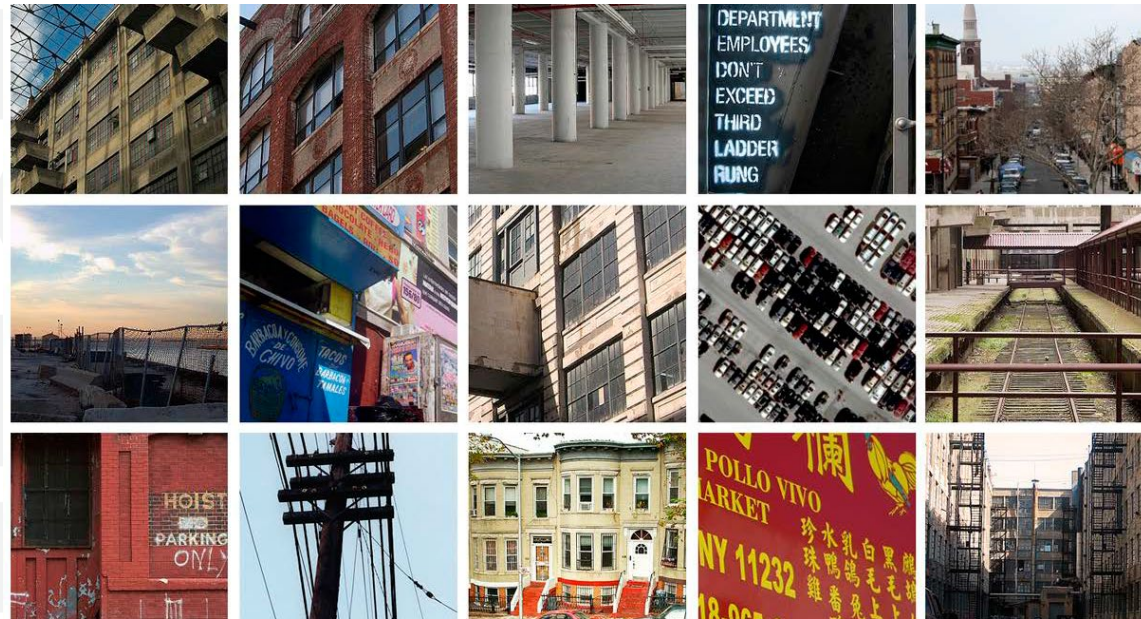

Origins of the Sunset Park Task Force

Origins of the Sunset Park Task Force

- In 2015, NYCEDC and Council Member Carlos Menchaca's Office entered into an Agreement that established the Sunset Park Waterfront Planning and Jobs Task Force (the "Task Force").
- The Points of Agreement Letter that established the Task Force was based on furtherance of the Community Board's 197a plan, as related to the RFP for an operator of the South Brooklyn Marine Terminal, newly released at the time.
- The purposes of the Task Force:
 1. Maximize the potential of the Sunset Park waterfront district and Red Hook waterfront to serve as an economic hub of traditional and innovating industries
 2. Establish and promote regional priorities for efficient goods movement
 3. Balance community access and needs across the city and private initiatives in the waterfront district
 4. Provide ongoing advocacy for industrial and manufacturing businesses
 5. Engage in long range planning for the future of the waterfront
 6. Communicate on an on-going basis with the surrounding community
