





PROPOSED SITE PLAN

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


OVERALL EAST ELEVATION

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


OVERALL WEST ELEVATION





















SITE WALL PLAN - AREA B (TYP)



\$5M Offshore Wind Ecosystem Fund

Context

 Context: In Dec 2020, Equinor committed to establishing a \$5M green energy innovation and community fund that supports initiatives that promote the growth of, and inclusivity within, the offshore wind industry in New York City and the local community

Objectives & Governance

- The Ecosystem Fund has three primary investment objectives: Scale talent pipeline in offshore wind-related careers; Support low-income New Yorkers and NYCHA residents in the green energy transition; Grow green energy innovation ecosystem in NYC
- Fund Governance: Strategy Development Committee responsible for developing investment strategies and a monitoring and evaluation (M&E) program to assess performance; Selection Committee charged with developing RFPs & identifying suitable organizations and/or partners to execute on the Strategy Development Committee's recommendations.

Qualifications for Strategy Development Committee SPTF Representatives

- Commitment to serving ~9-month term
- Demonstrated interest or experience in **clean energy industry**
- Demonstrated interest or experience in workforce development, supply chain development, or innovation initiatives in NYC
- Note: elected officials can only serve in advisory capacity, not as formal representatives

Made in NY Campus at Bush Terminal

North Campus Updates

- Garment Hub: Construction work ongoing and expected to be substantially complete by Summer 2022.
- **R&D Center/Workforce Training Partner Procurement:** We have narrowed the selection process down to 2 remaining candidates. We have an executed term sheet with one of those respondents. We hope to make a formal selection and finalize the contract this fall.
- **Public Realm:** Site work permitting is still ongoing. Finalizing Plans with DEP for the Internal water main work. Con ED work finalized for Power Distribution on the Campus, Pier 6 and Bush Park.

South Campus: Steiner Studios

- Site Work: The team is making progress toward key pre-development milestones, anticipating a closing in 2021/22; site plans advancing for agency approvals (submitted 8/21 for PDC Preliminary Review) and infrastructure design work underway
- **Construction Planning:** Steiner is currently engaged in the design development and extensive permits and approvals process and plans to break ground Q2 2022.
- Park Planning: The developer initiated public engagement on Bush Terminal Piers Park playground in January and is collaborating with Parks to refine final design

Bush Terminal Piers Park

- Lighting Project: All but two sets of lights were installed this summer, are operational. The remaining two require new foundation to be properly installed, and it is anticipated that installation of the final two will be complete before the end of the year.
- Sinkhole: This project has received all necessary approvals from NYCEDC's side, and it is estimated that work can begin Winter 2022, pending external departmental approvals.


Made in NY Campus at Bush Terminal

Pier 6


Presented in June 2021:

- New project to create a public amenity at MiNY by rehabilitating the pier to support the campus, similar to Pier 4 at the Brooklyn Army Terminal
- Detailed project scope to be determined, comprising public walkway access, maritime uses, public parking and components of the ecopier concept, if feasible
- Project scoping to kick off later this year, with public engagement on the scoping for public access and ecopier components, if feasible
- <u>UPDATE:</u> NYCEDC is in the process of engaging an engineering firm to assess the current condition of the Pier.





Brooklyn Wholesale Meat Market




- 215,000 SF Facility
- The Campus was built in the early 1970s and has not undergone an assessment of its condition since construction was built
- NYCEDC will engage a consultant to perform a conditions assessment this year

One Way Pair Study


- Draft feasibility report submitted to DOT for review in August 2021; awaiting agency comments

Workforce Trends

- Jobseekers connected to employment by the Brooklyn Workforce1 Industrial and Transportation Career Center (ITC):
- From December 1st, 2020, to July 31st, 2021, the Brooklyn Industrial & Transportation Workforce1 Career Center connected New Yorkers to 100* jobs (100% full-time) with an average wage of \$16.23 per hour.

Sunset Park residents (zip codes 11220, 11232) connected to employment by the Workforce1 system (across all locations):

 From December 1st, 2020, to July 31st, 2021, the Workforce1 system connected Sunset Park residents to 73* jobs with an average wage of \$18.98 per hour.
